

## Ballet Conservatory Class Rules

Saratoga Performing Arts would like to make it possible for every dancer to receive the best training possible. The following rules will assist the teacher and the student in creating an environment conducive to learning the technique and artistry of ballet. Please read this over with your child so that are both familiar with what is expected.

### **Dress Code:**

- Ballet leo (black, unless on specified)
- Pink Tights (we prefer professional pink with the seams down the leg and hole at the Bottom of the foot)
- No extra clothing (such as skirts, shirts, etc.... It makes it easier for the teacher to Correct the dancer's body placement)
- Pink ballet shoes (we prefer canvas, spilt sole. Please do not buy ballet shoes with "room to grow")
- Hair securely back in a bun (pony tails are NOT acceptable. Use bobby pins, hairnets, hair spray, etc.. to keep it out of the face and secure)

### **Behavior**

- No talking (if you have questions to what the teacher is going over, please raise Your hand)
- Get drinks and go to the bathroom before and after class, not during.
- Be attentive to the teacher and take corrections.

### **Attendance**

- Please arrive at lease five minutes in order to prepare yourself for class (stretch put shoes on, and be ready to go when class starts.) If you are late, please enter quietly and explain to the instructor why you are late. If you are more than 10 min. late you may be asked to sit and observe for that class.( Much can be learned of technique and artistry through observation.)
- Please try and attend every class. If an emergency arises, contact the office and let Them know why you or your child will not be at class.
